Guilty for neglecting a child

A 21 year old woman from Mappo village at Phalaborwa was found guilty by Suburban Magistrate Court for neglecting a child.

Mtshali Thobela was fined R210 000 or twelve months imprisonment, whichever suspended for two years.

Meanwhile, a 30 year old man, Mthobela Khosa, charged from South Eastridge, was found guilty by Sub-

urban Magistrate Court for theft.

Mthobela was fined 12 months imprisonment, half of which is suspended for five years conditionally.

Residents: Take note

Re Phalaborwa Municipality would like to draw the attention of Re Phalaborwa residents to take note of the urgent registration process which will commence from the June 4. Residents who qualify are requested to register as indigent. The following criteria apply if a household wants to register as indigent:

If the gross monthly income of all the members of the household does not exceed R1 000 per month, if the applicants' gross monthly income of all members of the household does not exceed the joint possession of two old age-pensioners at least R2 000 a month. The person/applicant applying on behalf of a household must be 18 years of age and above.
