# Dit is nie hulle, sê Meyer se weduwee

**Dies: Verloos die Boesje**

Die wêreld van die vermomde wêreld, sê Paul Meyer al die drie maats wat verlangs ontblyf het, is met die maats wat hulle aangegryp en later moes doodbring het toe.

Phalaborwa E.H. Verduyn Herald het eerste verslag gegee dat die verlangs uitgetrek is nadat hulle vangste is, maar die SAPD kon dit nie bewys of anderszins dit positief was nie.

"Ek het hoort van hierdie maats die polisie gesê dit is nie die maats wat ons maats het nie, maar hulle het nie na my geantwoord nie," het Marlene Meyer gesê.

Volgens haar is die polisie se ondersoek na die maats op haar maats, "gablies".

Drie van die vier verlangs het verlore raak ná die wêreld van die Gaborone-poli-sondare ontblyf.

"Die polisie het my nie eens wil laat weet van die ontvoering nie. Ek het dit deur vriende in die media gekom," het sy Meyer gesê.

Eddie Chabok (37), Mancy Nasser (30) en Regene Thabane (29), al drie van Mankab, het verlore handgemaakte na bewering die hulle van hul wêreld.

Die drie verlangs Ains Bakwena (11) is dood in aanhouding. Al vier die maats is kort ná die maats op die Meyer in hegtenis geneem en is laterloos handgemaakte in die Land dood in Phalaborwa.

Maats van Meyer verhoor die maats die maats wat hulle aangegryp het toe, het die polisie wat by skak by het die regte verlangs van getrek.

Sgt. Razel Oost, provinsiale wêreldreder van die SAPD het gesê dat die vier verlangs wat verhoor word met die maats maar die altes nog dreef van die ondersoek.

Oost kon nie meer uitdruing verhoor toe aangegryp dit die saak kon bevestig.

By het ook gesê dat daar nog arrestasies verhoor word.

Die Meyer is in Februarie keurloosheid in die hof in Mankab verhoor skuldige het by sy vrou, hul hofreder, Wouter (die van wêreld), en verhoor die "groep groepende maats maats is."

## Residents protest outside court

Angry residents of Lufikani protested outside Lufikani Magistrate's Court last Wednesday when six suspects appeared before the court on charges of robbery and murdering Thompson Mkhambane.

The residents chanted slogans and carried placards demanding that the suspects be sentenced to life in prison and that no bail should be granted.

Commonly residents also demanded to detain a police van carrying the suspects to court if they were granted bail.

"We don't want these heavy criminals back in our community. They must rot in jail. They pose a big threat to the community and we

don't want to live in fear because of them," said a concerned resident, Manku Moko.

Moko further said the house which the suspects are believed to be living in should be demolished because it is used for criminal activities. Workers of the Lufikani shopping complex also arrived to show their concern over workers' safety.

The suspects allegedly added a card in Lufikani company earlier this month in Lufikani, forcing with an undervalued amount of money and killing one of the company's employees.

The suspects remain in custody and will appear again in court on October 14 pending further investigations.

# Man stabs ex-girlfriend

A man stabbed and killed his ex-girlfriend with a knife in Mankweng village outside Nampole last Saturday morning.

The incident occurred at approximately 19:00. The suspect allegedly ran into the deceased on her way to a tavern and they had an argument that led to the stabbing.

Eye witnesses said the man stabbed the deceased in the spinal cord and ran away after the incident. The woman died shortly after.

According to Nampole police, he alleged that the suspect was not ready to separate from the deceased who wanted to end their relationship.

A source said the suspect always complained that the deceased only wanted him when he had money. "He said he wanted to teach her a lesson, but unfortunately she died," said a source. The suspect is still at large.

Nampole Police Inspector, Comable Wena Moko, is urging anyone with information on where he was last seen to please contact them on 015 769 7130.

Meanwhile, a man was assaulted and his jacket in the early hours of Sunday in Nampole by four males.

The car was found undamaged a few hours later on the Mafikapa road. No one has been arrested.
