## Locals join nationwide strike

Workers of Transnet in Phalabowa joined the nationwide strike last week in demand of wage increases.

The workers are demanding a 11% wage increase while management offers only 11%, which the workers have rejected.

The national strike, which commenced last Wednesday, is paralyzing rail and port operations.

The workers affiliated with South African Transport and Allied Workers Union (Satawu), United Transport and Allied Trade Unions (Uatwu) are demanding, amongst other things, that contracted employees who have been working for Transnet for 12 years or more should be employed permanently.

Local Satawu spokesperson, Willie Mkhale, said they will continue with the protest until their voices are heard.

## SAPS retrieves live rounds of ammunition from Blyde

Limpopo police retrieved about 3 000 live rounds of ammunition from Blyde River near Hardspan last week Wednesday.

This, after, according to Limpopo police spokesperson, Colonel Robert Otho, a militant drove over the Blyde

River bridge on Wednesday and ran 'a lot of stuff' beyond the river.

Otho said the militant contacted the Hardspan police station, who called in Limpopo's police officers.

Since the Limpopo police have only two officers, the Pretoria state wings were called

to assist.

The drivers spent about four hours in the water, while a colleague stood watch on the riverbank with an RT assault rifle just to ease the criminals' conscience.

Otho said they are investigating the origin of the rounds.

## Court sentences murderer

A murder suspect, Peter Masingangeni from Lubatani, was sentenced to 25 years imprisonment last Friday by the Lubatani Magistrate's Court.

Masingangeni was arrested last year November for killing 22 year old Mafikatar Mphahane who was apparently his girlfriend.

Masingangeni allegedly called Mafikatar's sister and told her that Mafikatar died after complaining about breast pain and said that she should ignore the police.

Mafikatar's body was found in the suspect's house lying on the floor in a pool of blood.

Masingangeni was found by the police and arrested in Mafikatar's house.

The police said the accused admitted to assaulting Mafikatar, but claimed she was still alive when he left the house.

# No bail for Phalaborwa trio

The African National Congress led Friday mobilised hundreds of its members and supporters to join them as they intensified their march outside the Phalaborwa Magistrate's Court in an attempt to oppose the bail application of four men accused of high treason and the vandalism of Ntseane Marabane's premises.

One of the four men accused, Andrew Ntsh (27), was granted bail of R1 000. However, Ntsh was ordered to report to the local police station every Friday and not to leave the jurisdiction of Phalaborwa without notifying the police.

The three remaining suspects, Gregorius Kiratzi, Marthinus Venter and Ryan Lwasa, pleaded guilty to charges of treason, citing that they were compelled to engage in any terrorist activities.

They however acknowledged the vandalism of the garage, putting the blame on alcohol and John Mubona's remarks to the media lately. They told the court that they apologise for any pain caused to the Marabane family and will take responsibility in fixing the garage as a sign of remorse.

The trio stated that they were physically tortured by the police and were taken away for days without their families and legal representatives knowing their whereabouts. During the bail application, legal repres-

entatives of the accused told the court that the suspects will not pose any harm to the community if released on bail and will comply with bail conditions should there be any.

In affidavits submitted to the court, the accused stated that members of Phalaborwa police's special investigation unit tortured them into making a previous statement saying that they admit to committing high treason, and that they found the police torturing prisoners to sexually exploit them.

One of the accused, who was allegedly reported in prison, is apparently an antiretroviral medicine to avoid contracting HIV/AIDS. He was apparently restrained by a man only known as Jan Black in the Phalaborwa prison. It was heard in the court that the accused allegedly had a map indicating the homes of ANC members in Phalaborwa, whom they were planning to attack.

It is also alleged that part of their plan was to target houses, leaving committees, Isaac Ntshale, Madibole and Isakane.

The case strongly stood in favour to oppose the bail application.

It stated that the witness of the accused on bail will bring a sense of shock and outrage in circles of communities. This was supported by hundreds of men from outside the court.

According to the spokesman of the special investigating unit, Musa Zurek, the police found the men with large quantities of we-

apons and ammunition.

Their bail application was heard again on

Wednesday May 19.

The Herald will keep readers updated on any further court proceedings.
